History

1994 - the National Graduate School of Public Administration under the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan (NGSPA) was created (on the basis of the Higher Party School under the Central Committee of the Kazakh SSR, established in 1942).

1998 - the Academy of Civil Service under the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan was created by merging the NGSPA under the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Institute for Retraining and Advanced Training of Civil Servants under the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

2000 - Relocation of the Academy of Civil Service under the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the capital of Kazakhstan – Astana

2005 - the Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan was established through the merger of the state institutions "Academy of Civil Service under the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan", "Judicial Academy under the Supreme Court of the Republic of Kazakhstan" and the transmission of the functions of the Diplomatic Academy to the state enterprise "Eurasian National University named after L.N. Gumilyov".

2008 - the Academy was reorganized into the Republican state-owned enterprise (RSE). The National School of Public Policy was established within the Academy to train senior civil servants.

2017-2023 - 17 branches of the Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan were established in regional centers as well as Almaty and Shymkent cities.



39 DOCTORAL DEGREE STUDENTS

In the Central Office of the Academy, there are **62 faculty members**, of whom **54** individuals hold academic degrees, representing 87.1% of the total staff (11 Doctor of Sciences, 22 Candidates of Sciences, 21 PhD holders).

In the Academy's branches, the actual number of faculty and staff is **52** individuals, with a degree attainment rate of **50%** (4 Doctors of Sciences, 16 Candidates of Sciences, and 6 PhD holders).

Among the teaching staff of the Academy, **11 members** hold diplomas from leading international universities, with **7** individuals having completed their studies through the prestigious program "Bolashak". Additionally, **5** employees of the Academy have successfully completed internships at the Maxwell School of Syracuse University.

THROUGH THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

- The Academy is the only higher educational institution with a legislatively established status that provides training, retraining, and professional development for government officials.
- the Academy plays a crucial role as a facilitator and promoter of the social and economic policies through the professional development of the government personnel
- Disciplines aimed at improving the social life and economic life of the country: "Sustainable development and economic growth," "Sustainable regional development," "Environmental policy in regional development," "Tools for regional planning and forecasting," "Urban management," "Social regional policy."

THROUGH THE RESEARCH COMPONENT

- Project within the framework of grant financing from the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan: "Management of regional food security in the face of global challenges based on the concept of Data Driven Decision Making."
- Project within the framework of grant financing from the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan: "Management of regional competitiveness in the context of sustainable development of Kazakhstan based on the concept of Evidence-based policy."
- Participation is planned in the development of programs for the management of water resources.



The contribution of the Academy to the implementation of the goals and objectives of the HWCA project



- The Academy will be implementing courses on water diplomacy as modules within the International Relations program. This will
 enable students to acquire the knowledge and skills necessary for effective water resources management and broaden their range
 of competencies.
- Within the disciplines of "Politics and Security of the Central Asian Region" (4th semester) and "Foreign Policy of the Republic of Kazakhstan" (1st semester), as well as the elective course "Modern Integration Processes in the Eurasian Space" (2nd semester) and the doctoral program (elective course "Republic of Kazakhstan and Central Asian Countries", 2nd semester), modules will be included to develop competencies in the field of water diplomacy in Central Asia.
- **Module 1.** Issues of Water Diplomacy in Central Asia: This module will examine key problems and challenges related to the management and allocation of water resources in Central Asia.
- **Module 2.** Integrated Water Resources Management in Central Asia: This module will focus on the development and implementation of integrated approaches to water resources management in Central Asia.
- Module 3. Issues of Joint Use of Transboundary Rivers in Central Asia: This module will focus on the issues related to the joint use
 of transboundary rivers in Central Asia.





- The Academy will actively contribute to the retraining of a new generation of experts in water resources management and water diplomacy by offering short-term programs. These programs will be designed with consideration for contemporary trends and best practices in water management and diplomacy
- The Academy will focus its efforts on training a new generation of leaders in the field of water resources management in Central Asia. Special attention will be given to preparing managers in water diplomacy who are capable of effectively managing water resources and addressing international water issues

- Strengthening the professional and scientific-analytical capacity of experts in Water Diplomacy through participation in the project
